- Free Money: \$360-ish accrued this year (against a goal of \$1300) should be at ½ of our goal in the next month or two; possibly doing 1 week or 10 day contest in the classrooms to earn a reward (pajama day); Erin is working on Shoparoo, Amazon Smile is on hold pending 403 status; Dr. Grengs will send out a reminder on Shoparoo
- **Spirit Wear:** Holiday shopping night event sold about \$600 worth of clothes that night, there was a preschool program going on that night which increased revenue; right before holidays they tested a couple of Saturday opens during elementary open houses (very, very successful); just put in a large request of new clothes, hope to have that in time for conferences and would like to add a few more open dates; #1 selling item in youth boys Under Armour shirt, #2 is gray Tiger Pride sweatshirt; samples available during meeting to see
- **Book Fair:** another book fair coming in March, looking to see who will take over for next year to shadow for spring book fair and the May BOGO book fair; Jen & Courtney will both be vacating their roles after this year; best if we can have 2 people; suggestion to put out in e-blast to request volunteers; Dr. Grengs would like a description of the role to send out; it's a fun role!!
