Call to order: 6:30

Welcome and Introductions – Jamie J & Marjane

PTP Project Teams

- PIE Heidi
 - Got 2 additional volunteers
 - We expect more work after MEA so encourage all who are interested to attend
- Free Money Jeff
 - Have made 2 submissions of box tops probably \$400 so far, anticipate we will meet or exceed our year goal of \$1200
 - Wendy & Jeff will connect on registering with Amazon Smile
 - Still considering pursuing Shoparoo
 - Erin and Jeff looked at the calendar and with everything (Glow Run, holidays, etc) going on may wait until after the first of the year to do any type of classroom contest
- Spirit Wear Jaime F
 - 5 sales so far this year
 - Some popular items are the Under Armour items, boys hoodies, pink patch tees
 - Last year we did a holiday sale online but didn't generate the amount of sales to make the effort worth it
 - Would like to do an in person sale from 5-7 toward the end of November
 - Suggestion made to open this up to the other schools as well. Many do the order form holiday sale but we could offer the in person sale
 - Having a hard time finding volunteers for the early hours
 - Question came up about bringing younger children with if a parent comes to work earlier and this is acceptable
 - At Homecoming we had many people coming in from other schools to buy things because other schools don't have a store

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- Consider for next year: offering a day for other schools to come in and order spirit wear and each school would get some portion of the profits (although RVES would also receive some of the profit)
- Suggested that the other schools only receive a kickback if they send volunteers to staff their day
- No one had a strong objection to this and so Jaime and Amber will connect with other PTP groups to discuss this possibility
- Amber will be at the November meeting to provide a financial update regarding the spirit shop
- Book Fair
 - \circ $\;$ Book fair went on last week over conferences, no one present to report out
- Volunteer Coordinators Lindsey/Jaime T
 - Eblast reminder helping tremendously, people know where to find volunteer opportunities
 - Directory is done
 - ~350 families submitted their information
 - Printing area is short staffed, likely won't have them available until next week
 - We can't send out electronically because only families who submitted information get a copy so there are restrictions
 - Suggestion made to send out an email to the PTP group if unfilled volunteer spots urgently need to be filled
- Tiger Pantry Christina
 - Spoke with Michelle R. and her plan is to continue to do the same thing as in previous years
 - Plan to start with kindergarten in November to restock the pantry
 - Suggestion made to maybe do a Turkey Bingo or Christmas Bingo at the end of a PTP meeting, must bring an item to the Tiger Pantry in order to play
 - Jamie and Christina will discuss further
- Fall Fundraiser Gretchen
 - October 24th is the first day that Boosterthon will be on site meeting with the kids and getting them excited (kickoff pepfest)
 - Boosterthon will also meet with teachers that day, students have the whole week to collect pledges
 - Actual run occurs on November 2nd
 - T-shirts are coming soon

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- Volunteer and staff shirts are Boosterthon shirts (not the same as what the kids get)
- o Volunteer slots are open for the day of the run
- Vicky is available on the day of the run to field questions (Gretchen won't be available)
- All of the grades are running at different times (45 minute slots)
- Decision was made to not open the run to parents
- Our fundraising goal is \$32,000 (each child needs to raise a little less than \$100 for us to reach our goal)
 - If we don't reach our goal, we can always add a spring fundraiser'
- Ms. Berg will put everything out on the FB page so Gretchen will send info to her and she can post it on the FB page

- Next week starts Community Building, next Friday they start partnering classrooms together
- Every elementary school has been partnering over the past week with Pellicci Ace Hardware to send buckets for hurricane relief
 - We reached our goal of 25 buckets!
- Working on emergency drills (fire drills, lockdown drills)
