Funding Requests – Marjane

- 2 tabled from last meeting (more information needed):
 - Sonday kits for kindergarten \$1047 APPROVED
 - District does not pay
 - The corporation who supplies them has provided free cost kits in the past
 - This would benefit kindergarten for years to come
 - Nancy Carlson author visit \$850 (\$800 fee + cost of lunch for a group) APPROVED
 - All elementary schools will participate if we choose not to, we'd be the only school not participating
 - Nancy Carlson will come spend the day
 - All students will get to meet the author
 - Smaller group will meet with her and have a lunch
- Play Bins for Break times for kids 3rd grade \$1000-1500 per teacher TABLED
 - Inspired by Global Day of Play
 - o How can we bring more joy into the classroom?
 - Make connections from play to learning



- Requesting money to buy things for toy bins (gears, puzzle mats, Legos, Mad Libs, building blocks, Rush Hour, STEM based activities)
- Suggestion to create a Sign Up Genius to send to parents with a link to Amazon where parents can order games or activities
- Also can solicit donations of Legos from families
- First step is to try for donations from families to see what we get, then bring back for PTP vote to fund other items that we don't get
- Math Manipulatives (3rd grade) \$1000 APPROVED
 - o Kids learning through hands-on games and activities during Math Menu time
 - Teachers spend lots of time packing and unpacking items (lots of prep time)
 - Would like to package all items in activities and then could be stored permanently and used in the Math Resource Room (this would benefit other grades as well)
- Dancing Sue (3rd grade) \$3000 APPROVED
 - o Funding for next year
 - This is in the budget already
- Idea to modify the funding request sheet to include if this is a recurring request and/or how many years they've received this funding (to provide context for PTP decision making)
- Also idea to require teachers to present their funding request if it is greater than \$500
- Could we have some of these as consent agenda items so that all requests don't have to be presented at the PTP meeting
- Teachers are very careful about using the district supply budget staff does a great job of managing this which allows a lot of funding needs to be covered out of that

<u>Board Positions</u> – President and Dr. Grengs are working on an email for board members for next year so anyone who will not be able to fulfill their responsibilities for next year should let Jamie & Marjane know.

Board will continue to meet on Tuesdays through the summer to plan for next year.
