PTP Minutes - September 20, 2016

President Tani Helgemoe brought the meeting to order. 13 parents and 2 staff members were present.

Welcome & Introductions

Financial Report - Tani Helgemoe

- Tani explained that the Financial report is all about transparency and being able to show that all the money that is raised here at Riverview goes back to supporting our school, teachers and students.
- Tani highlighted a few of the areas that generate profit such as:
 - Spirit Wear brought in over \$10,000 profit last year
 - Pep Fest...although not a huge profit event, we have had success in selling Raffle Baskets (last year generated approx. \$1000)
 - Looking at possibly doing a Silent Auction for the next PepFest, which is Jan. 27
 - O Culvers...Riverview is not doing Culvers this year, but we are looking into Toppers as a replacement. Toppers does pizza delivery in the metro area.
- Tani reviewed the 2015-2016 Treasury Report...last year we raised \$46,666.20!
 - Review of Funded Activities
 - Tiger Pantry is one of the funded activities. The Tiger Pantry is a food shelf located inside Riverview, just outside of Kathy Willhoite's office. It is available to anyone, just grab what is needed, no questions asked. The grade levels take turns each month to stock the shelf. Michelle Ronnebaum is the person that oversees the Tiger Pantry.
- Wendy Carlson is the Treasurer for 2016-2017 and will do the financial report at the next meeting.

Funding Requests – Tani Helgemoe and Ria Cammack

- 1. I-Nature request for a Yearly Fund for an Animal Vet for the animals in our I-Nature program.
 - a. Requested by Cinda Current, will benefit all grades...\$100 requested (if funds are not used they can roll into the next year)
 - b. In the past vet duties were handled by a parent from Riverview, but that family has "graduated" so a vet may be needed from time to time. The Critter Corner has been turned into a First grade classroom this year, but the animals have been rearranged(most into Mrs. Current's room)
 - c. The \$100 is in addition to the \$400 that has already been budgeted for animal lab expenses like food, materials, etc.
 - d. Ria moved to approve, Jen Cole second. Motion approved
- 2. I-Nature request for a garden storage shed for use to store tools, etc. to care for the gardens around RVES
 - a. Requested by Cinda Current, will benefit all grades...\$300-\$400 requested
 - b. Dan will pound it into the ground so that the shed won't blow away. It will be locked.
 - c. Wendy Carlson moved to approve, Ria second. Motion approved.
