### PTP Minutes – February 2016 2/16/16

# Funding Requests (Tricia Murphy):

- Two funding requests
  - o 1. School Patrol/Twins trip transportation by Claire Berg
    - Amount requested is \$466.56 for bussing of school patrol students to the Twins game on May 11 (students pay for their own tickets) ... benefits 56 students
    - The PTP has already budgeted money towards School Patrol for this year, so this request is approved.
  - 2. Grade 3/4/5 Book Olympics
    - Amount requested is \$120 for 12 medals for each grade level and 10-12 Book Challenge Medals
    - Motion to approve by Teresa Gibbs, Second by Michelle R.

### Principal Report/Discussion Topic (Given by Dr. Kim Grengs):

- Congratulations to Kim for earning the title Dr.!!!
- Feb. 26 is the night of Riverview's Pep Fest, 6pm to 8:30pm
- Feb. 26 is the start of the Winter/Spring Book Fair. Teacher luncheon will be held on Feb. 26. The book fair will **not** be open during the Pep Fest.
- March 1 and 3 are Parent Teacher Conferences. The times a little different because of the caucus on Tuesday.
  - The PTCFast link for scheduling conferences is on the Riverview webpage for scheduling conferences.
  - Staff Dinner on March 1 provided by the PTP...3:10 to 3:30 might be a busy time for teachers to grab a bite to eat...suggestion to possibly do something lighter since conferences end at 6 so teachers may want to go home and have dinner with their families.
- Renovations at Riverview this summer
  - The locker rooms will become 4-5 classrooms
  - The current art room and the Special Ed room that Alysha Olson uses will become Kindergarten rooms.
  - A security system will be installed and the office area will be changed.
  - Meeting with architects to work on plans.
- Staffing for 2016-2017 school year
  - $\circ$  Probably going to need to add a section in 5<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Multiage possibly extend to 5<sup>th</sup> grade?
    - There was feedback from parents that 5<sup>th</sup> grade is a big year of setting the expectation for what the 5<sup>th</sup> graders will experience in middle school and the Riverview 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers did a great job of prepping students for that, so not too sure about a multiage class that is 4/5 ?
  - There will be 6 sections of Kindergarten
  - Probably no teachers looping next year.
- Culvers Nights
  - The staff would like to stop doing Culvers Night next year (It's a longer distance to travel to Lakeville and the staff would rather help with or attend other evening functions like Pep Fest/PTP meetings)
  - Will continue for the rest of the current school year and not start again next year.
- There will be no April Flex Learning Day...it is changed to an In School Learning Day...students report to Riverview that day.
- Question raised about Snow Day having to be a Flex Learning Day...aren't snow days built into schedule...why can't it just be a day of no school?

- Most likely snow days are not going to happen in our district since we do have the technology and can make use of it.
- Everyone is still learning on how to manage amount and kind of work. Make sure to complete the parent surveys.
- Two scheduled Flex Learning days are planned for next year but things are not finalized so share your feedback.
- NWEA testing is done. The classes/students that used I pads had a good experience, it went well. So MCA testing will most likely be done on I pads.
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be doing the MN Survey on March 4, also on I pads.
- Riverview Science Fair is this week

Last month 7 more bags of over flow food were donated to the Farmington Food Shelf!
- The use of the shelf by families at the school has gone up.
- Kim Grengs approved moving the location of the pantry to a more discrete location. That change can happen immediately. Michelle to send out an EBlast about the change of location once it happens. Please remember after the construction changes take place over the summer that we will need a place for the Food Shelf.
